How do I know I am doing enough?

The current minimum level of activity recommended for adults is 30 minutes of moderate level activity on five different days of the week (Department of Health 1996).

The physical signs of moderate level activity are:

- you get slightly warmer
- your heart is beating faster than usual, but not racing
- your breathing is deeper and more rapid than usual, but you can still talk

Who can apply?

The pass is available to both residents and non-residents of the borough of Rugby. If one of the following statements applies to you, then you can qualify for the leisure pass. (please tick the relevant box)

- I am in work-based learning for adults**

- I am aged 16-18**
(Proof of date of birth/proof of address)
- I am aged 60+**
(Proof of date of birth/bus pass/birth certificate/proof of address)
- I receive carer's allowance in receipt of income support**
(Allowance book or entitlement letter/proof of address)
- Children in Care & Young People eligible for leaving care services**
(Foster Care ID)
