



National Pool Lifeguard Qualification Course

The National Pool Lifeguard Qualification (NPLQ) is the national qualification widely accepted as the minimum qualification for the role of lifeguard in swimming pools.

The course is made up of two units:

Unit 1 – The Principles of Supervision;

Unit 2 – The Application of Supervision and Rescue in a Swimming Pool.

Course pre-requisites:

Applicants must be competent to jump/dive into deep water, swim 50 metres in no more than 60 seconds, swim 100 metres continuously on front and back, tread water for 30 seconds in deep water, surface dive to the deepest part of the pool and climb out of the pool unaided without using steps or ladder.
