IN2 Leisure discount card

What is the IN2 leisure discount card?

Waverley Borough Council's concessionary IN2 scheme offers residents discounts on many leisure centre activities throughout the Borough.

What does the IN2 card entitle me to?

The scheme offers the following savings:

- 50%** off casual swimming
- 50%** off membership and joining fee
- 50%** off inductions to the gym (booked in advance)
- 50%** off casual use of the gym (once inducted)
- 50%** off centre-run group fitness classes
(e.g.aerobics/aqua)
- 50%** off squash, badminton and tennis
- 50%** off soft play for children
- 50%** off centre-run children's activities

Am I entitled to the IN2 card?

If you live in Waverley and receive:

- Job seeker's allowance (Income based)
- Disability living allowance
- Attendance allowance
- Pension credit (Guarantee credit)
- Income support
- Working tax credit
- Child tax credit (conditions apply).

Or you are:

- Aged between 16 and 19 and registered on a full-time educational course
- A full-time student with a current NUS card
- A student nurse
- A full time registered carer.

You are entitled to the IN2 card. The card is valid for up to **12 months.**



How do I get an IN2 card?

Visit one of the following sites with proof of eligibility (a letter from the benefit agency or student identification) and a passport photo:

A member of staff will ask you to complete an application form and will then issue you with a membership card. You must show your IN2 card each time you visit a leisure centre.

- Godalming Leisure Centre
- The Herons Swimming and Fitness Centre, Haslemere
- The Edge Leisure Centre, Haslemere.

- 5 If you apply for a card when you are not entitled to it you could be subject to legal action. If your circumstances change and you are no longer eligible for the card you must stop using it immediately. If you go on using the card when you know you are not entitled to do so, you could be subject to legal action.
- 6 If your card is lost or stolen we will charge **£5** to provide you with a replacement and you will need to provide another photograph.
